


Please follow these instructions carefully

The facsimile is extremely heavy and should be handled with great care to avoid damage. Once you develop the method of opening it you will be able to enjoy it without fear of damaging it.


To remove the companion volume pull the narrow ribbon. When replacing, ensure that the ribbon remains outside its' box and on your left.

The Kennicott Bible is a Hebrew manuscript and opens from left to right.







Lift up the side containing the facsimile to expose a gap



Slide the facsimile to the right




Gripping it firmly lift it out




Apply pressure to the spine . . .
